

SEA KAYAK DOLPHIN TOUR

Bunbury



Explore the lower Collie River, Leschenault Estuary and beautiful Koombana Bay. Observe wild pods of dolphins in their natural habitat before going ashore on the peninsula for a swim and a cuppa. Paddle with dolphins and paddle-surf if the swell is up. Keep an eye out for Terns, Oyster Catchers and Ospreys and discover the history of the infamous local JB O Reilly. Learn to fish for herring and tailor from a kayak and search for reptiles, flora and fauna on the peninsula.

COST: Adults \$80, Students \$60, Families (2x2) \$220

Tour includes all equipment and morning tea

TIME: Daily Tour 8.30am – 12.30pm (Subject to numbers)

DEPARTS: Pelican Point Canals Estate boat ramp, Eaton

WHAT TO BRING: Waterproof footwear, swimwear, personal medication, one litre of water, broad brimmed hat, long sleeved shirt, wind proof parka or jacket, polarised sunglasses and a waterproof camera.

Hamelin Bay Tour

Explore Hamelin Bay from the water. Sea Kayak to the island where you can snorkel, fish, discuss the local history, visit the lighthouse and admire the views.

Duration: 4 hours , **Depart:** 9am Hamelin Bay boat ramp.

Minimum of 8 people – Adults \$80, Students \$60, Families (2x2) \$225

Bunkers Bay Tour

Paddle Bunkers Bay and explore Cape Naturaliste. View cliffs and caves, fish from your kayak, paddle/surf the bays and observe the resident seals and marine life of the area.

Duration: 5-6 hours, **Depart:** 9am Bunkers Bay

Minimum of 6 people – Adults \$100, Students \$85, Families (2x2) \$250
